We proclaim to you the one who existed from the beginning, whom we have heard and seen. We saw him with our own eyes and touched him with our own hands. He is the Word of life. This one who is life itself was revealed to us, and we have seen him. And now we testify and proclaim to you that he is the one who is eternal life. (cont'd)

He was with the Father, and then he was revealed to us. We proclaim to you what we ourselves have actually seen and heard so that you may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. We are writing these things so that you may fully share our joy.



### What is Gnosticism?

(John is combatting and early form of Gnostic heresy)

- Gnostic="gnosis" special knowledge
- What is the special knowledge?
- Very old, many forms
- Dualism—conflict between flesh and spirit
  - Usually flesh bad, spirit good
- Emanations and Aeons separate humanity from truth
- Great teachers show their followers the steps to secret truth, or more precisely awaken the truth in you.



Therefore Christ (God) cannot have flesh

True love comes from loving Jesus in truth and expresses itself in loving others



Story of Duke Raynald III (14th Century) who lived life of indulgence and was obese. His younger brother Edward fought him for inheritance and won – promised to treat him lovingly - constructed a room around him in a castle but made doors and windows too small for him to escape. Said if he could lose weight and fit through door/windows he could have his freedom. Every day he send him tasty food! Raynald trapped for 10 years before he died. This is example of false love – seems loving but has a controlling agenda – ulterior motive. True love is not their motivation. This is how cults work.

### 1 John 2:24-25

24 "Therefore let that abide in you which you heard from the beginning. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, you also will abide in the Son and in the Father. 25 And this is the promise that He has promised useternal life.

The result of abiding in His love is that we will possess eternal life now and forever with great joy.
